The Kent County Show takes place at Detling on Friday, 17th, Saturday, 18th, and Sunday, 19th July 2009 and Scouts and Explorer Scouts aged between 13 and 19 years may apply to work as Stewards on any or all of the three days. The number is limited to 30 young people per day.

Entrance tickets to the Show are provided and Parking at the Show Ground is free. However, Transport to the Show Ground is NOT provided by the County and must be arranged either by Parents or on a Group basis.

Camping A limited number of Explorer Scouts, who are attending all three days, will be permitted to camp in the Showground on the Scout Site. Arrangements for reporting to the Showground on the Thursday evening will be provided to those accepted to camp. All meals will be provided.

Attending Daily Those not Camping will be required to report to the Scouter at GATE No.3 of the County Show Ground between 0800 and 0830 hrs each morning. They will be free to leave by 5.00 pm from the same Gate. Sandwiches will be provided for lunch.

It will NOT be possible to attend for only part of a day.

Free time will be given for all young people to look round the Show themselves.

DUTIES will consist of helping the Livestock Stewards as required during the morning and carrying Breed Banners in the Livestock Parade in the afternoon.

UNIFORM

The Young People are representing Kent Scouting and are, therefore, expected to attend in correct Uniform, so that they are a credit to their Group/Unit and to Scouting.

Trousers or skirts, if not uniform, should be Navy blue and as smart as possible. Jeans or Tracksuits must NOT be worn. With the possibility of being near large animals, boots or other suitable footwear should be worn.

If attending on Friday, Young People must obtain permission to be absent from their School/ College/ Work, as appropriate. The County Scout Office will contact Schools / Colleges to verify absence.
